THE RUSSIAN CHURCH ABROAD'S COMMISSION ON DIALOG WITH THE ORTHODOX CHURCH IN AMERICA MEETS FOR THE FIRST TIME

On August 4-5, 2009, the first preliminary meeting of the Commission on Dialog of the Russian Orthodox Church Outside of Russia (ROCOR) with the Orthodox Church in America (OCA) was held at Holy Trinity Monastery in Jordanville, NY. This commission was formed by a decision of the Synod of Bishops of ROCOR on May 5, 2009. This preparatory meeting discussed organizational matters. The next meeting of the Commission will be held in November.
