THE MIRACLE OF ARCHANGEL MICHAEL AT COLOSSAE

In the 4th century, certain pagans were moved to destroy God's church in a place called Kherotopa and to this end they diverted two mountain streams into one watercourse directed toward the church. In response to the prayers of St Archippus, the sacristan, Archangel Michael appeared near the church and opened a wide fissure in the mountain and ordered the torrent to flow into it. At the sight of such a wonderful miracle, the pagans fled in terror. The site of the miracle became known as Chonae, which means "fissure" or "plunging."
