### Patrick of Ireland

COMMEMORATED THIS DAY WITH ALL THE SAINTS OF ENGLAND & IRELAND

Our father among the saints, Bishop of Armagh and Enlightener of Ireland, was born a Briton [340ad (?)]. Captured and brought to Ireland as a slave, he escaped and returned home. Later, he returned to Ireland, bringing Christianity to its people. His feast day is March 17<sup>th</sup>. Saint Patrick is most often recognized for likening the Trinity to a shamrock, illustrating that the shamrock has three parts, and yet is one; in a similar way, the Trinity has three persons, and is still one God.

### Aidan of Lindisfarne

Aidan of Lindisfarne, Enlightener of Northumbria (?-651), was the founder and first bishop of the monastery on the island of Lindisfarne off the northeast coast of England. A Christian missionary, he is credited with restoring Christianity to Northumbria (Northern England). His feast day is August 31<sup>st</sup>.

If you are able, we particularly try to stand during the processions with the Gospel and the Gifts, during the Readings, the Creed, during the preparation of the Holy Eucharist, the Lord's Prayer and reception of Communion. \* **We invite you** to stay after the Thanksgiving Prayers **for fellowship** and coffee, so that we may greet you personally, and to answer any questions you may have about our faith, our parish or today's service. \* Please help yourself to the brochures and information on the east side counter. \* All children **ages three through twelve** are encouraged to attend our Sunday School after Holy Communion.

### Columba of Iona

COMMEMORATED THIS DAY WITH ALL THE SAINTS OF ENGLAND & IRELAND

Our venerable and God-bearing Father Enlightener of Scotland (also known as **Columcille** [521-597], meaning "Dove of the Church") was an Irish missionary who helped re-introduce Christianity to Scotland and the north of England. He traveled to Scotland, where it is reputed he first landed at the southern tip of the Kintyre peninsula, near Southend. However, being still in sight of his native land he moved further north up the west coast of Scotland. In 563 he founded a monastery on the island of Iona off the west coast of Scotland which became the centre of his evangelizing mission to Scotland. There are many stories of miracles which he performed during his mission to convert the Picts.
